General Information

IF YOU ARE PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED AND REQUIRE ASSISTANCE, PLEASE LET THE FRONT DESK KNOW. We hope your stay is a pleasant one. Please help us provide a happy camping experience for all our guests by following these simple rules:

- Check out time 11:00 AM** - if staying over or leaving late, please make arrangements at office PRIOR to 11:00 AM.
- Pet Policy** - Pets are welcomed. YOU must be in full and constant control of your pet(s) including being on a chain or leash no longer than 6 ft. at all times, clean up after it/them and not allow them to howl or bark. They are not to be left unattended, are not allowed in or near the buildings or in the playground. There are two walk areas in the camp: at the entrance of the camp and at the back of the camp.
- Fire** - Being an ever present threat in our timbered area, we permit fires IN GRILLS ONLY - No open or ground fires permitted. Please help us protect our trees, shrubs and grass!
- Children** - We expect parents to be responsible for their children at all times; in restrooms, recreation room and about the campground.
- Water** - NO vehicles to be washed or rinsed in your space. Water used must be prevented from flowing beyond your assigned space.
- Trash** - Please place in appropriate outdoor containers located area.

- throughout the camp. Please keep your site clean and orderly - report any condition needing our attention. Please do not use the grills for ashtrays or trash. **Please Recycle**
- Speed Limit- 5 MILES PER HOUR!** All motorized units are limited to incoming and outgoing traffic. Licensed drivers only. Motorcycles and mopeds are to be ridden to and from your site only. Bikes may be ridden on the roads in the camp - NOT ridden through campsites, nor obstruct traffic entering or leaving the campground. No motorized scooters or mini trail bikes allowed.
- Safety** - No firearms, bows and arrows, air guns, paint guns or sling shots may be used or carried in the camping area.
- Playground** - Open for use from 7:00 AM til 9:00 PM. **Quiet Hours** - 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM - Please observe as many of our guests are traveling and need a restful evening.
- We reserve the right** to evict anyone for violating the rules of good camping, destroying property, or creating a disturbance.

- To relieve congestion during evening hours, we suggest the early kamperns take advantage of showers & laundry before the rush.

- DURING WINTER MONTHS** - We ask that you shut the water off with the L rod at the base of your water pipes at night:
WATER ON: Turn all faucets off; turn L rod 1/4 turn counter clockwise.
WATER OFF: Turn L rod 1/4 turn clockwise; open all faucets.
WITH FROST FREE WATER HYDRANTS: Lift top handle up for water, push down handle to stop water.
